

Thirty primary candidates, endorsed by Represent PA, move toward the finish line

Special election win flips the 178th from red to blue

PHILADELPHIA, May 16, 2018 – On the day after the Pennsylvania primary election, 30 women candidates who were endorsed by Represent PA, won their races and are moving on to the general election in November. Represent PA, the only organization in Pennsylvania focused on investing in Democratic women candidates for the Pennsylvania General Assembly, previously endorsed 32 candidates. Nine of those endorsed women were running against challengers, and seven won, with Helen Tai winning her special election in legislative district 178 – flipping that seat from red to blue. The women who won yesterday, are:

"We are so excited to see the possibility of improving women's representation in the PA legislature.
