

# The Pennsylvania Legislature is not supporting its residents

## **Campaign Finance Reform**

- Pennsylvania is one of 11 states with no campaign finance limits for Governor or Legislature 13
- PA state lawmakers are among the highest paid in U.S., but do less actual lawmaking
- PA is one of only two states that doesn't explicitly ban or limit candidates from spending campaign donations on personal expense

## **Community Health and Gun Violence Prevention**

- Pennsylvania is one of four states with the highest opioid deaths
- Since the Parkland shooting, 26 states (including 15 with Republican governors) have passed and signed 55 laws addressing the gun-violence crisis; but not PA 9
- In PA, African American women are 3X more likely to die during or after pregnancy than white women 31

## **Criminal Justice Reform**

• Pennsylvania's proposed risk-assessment tool, giving judges the necessary information to divert low-risk individuals from prison to alternative sentencing programs is racist 23

## **Economic Equality**

- PA is one of 21 states still using the Federal minimum wage of \$7.25 an hour. Nearby states: Maryland, Delaware, New Jersey, New York and Ohio all pay higher wages
- PA is the 6th worst state in which to start a new business 21
- PA is 24th in the nation for worker-friendly policies 25
- The poverty rate is 60% higher within three miles of power plants compared to the rest of the state 30

#### Education

- PA school funding is most unequal (rich vs. poor districts) in the nation due to over-emphasis on local funding <sup>1</sup>
- PA residents graduate from college with the highest amount of debt in the country <sup>2</sup>
- Pennsylvania ranks 30<sup>th</sup> in the US in quality of public education for all <sup>3</sup>
- Pre-K program spending is well below PA's border states who spend four times what we do
- PA has the worst community college system when considering in-state tuition and graduation rates <sup>22</sup>

## **Environmental Protection and Infrastructure**

- Pennsylvania ranks 44 in the state of our natural environment
- Pennsylvania is the only state that does not tax those pulling oil and gas from our state
- Pennsylvania has the third worst drinking water in the country
- PA got a C- grade from the American Society of Civil Engineers for aging/deteriorating water & sewage systems
- Pennsylvania is ranked #2 for having the most structurally deficient bridges in the US
- PA's roads are the 5th worst in the nation 24
- PA Power Sector was labeled 5th dirtiest in the nation <sup>27</sup>
- People of color are 39% of the population living within three miles of existing & proposed power plants; yet they are only 22% of PA's total population <sup>30</sup>

### **Equity and LGBTQ+ Rights**

- Pennsylvania has no statewide law prohibiting discrimination against LGBTQ people, meaning it is legal to fire someone, evict them from housing, or deny them service at a restaurant just because they are lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender or queer "
- PA ranks 40 of 50 states in the share of women in elected office; this is up in 2019 from 49 19,12

## Livability

Pennsylvania ranked 41 out of 50 in an annual ranking of most livable states that looks at health care, education, economy, infrastructure, opportunity, fiscal stability, crime & corrections, and natural environment; this is down from 38 last year 18; related to infrastructure and economy, PA is 29 out of 50 in broadband access

## **Reproductive Rights and Access**

• 82% of Pennsylvania counties have no abortion providers or Medicaid does not cover abortion. Public funding is available for abortion only in cases of life endangerment, rape or incest <sup>10</sup>
